Play and learn with our state-of-the-art interactive exhibits.

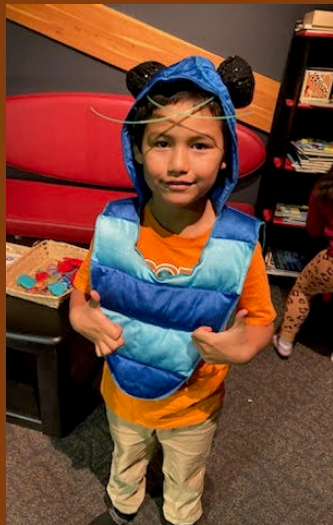
