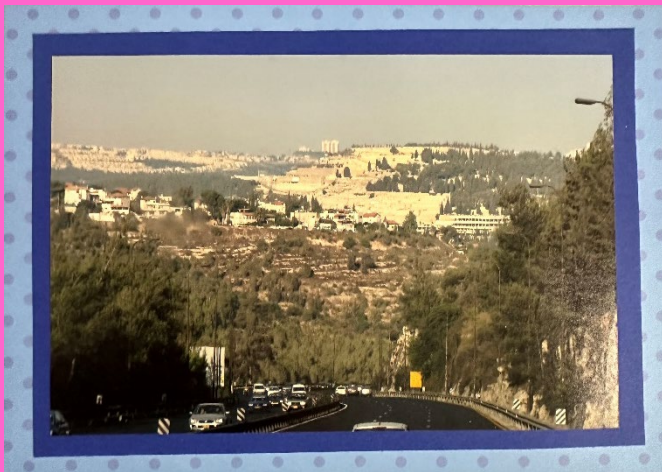
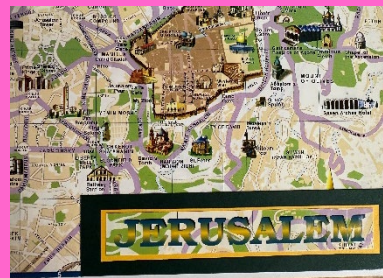
While we await our newly seeded soccer field to flourish, you can see by how worn our small field is how dedicated our soccer players are!
