Programs Offered

Preschool: Monday-Friday 8:30-12:30)

Daycare: Monday-Friday 12:30- 3:00

Afterschool: Monday-Friday 3:10-5:00

DayCare: From 12:30-3:00

if you are requiring your child stay past 3:00 I will need
to know, so I can put in for a temporary placement through licensing.

The temporary placement needs to be in order before a child can stay past 3:00. This
process can take up to a month, so the sooner the better.

All Children are to bring the following things for the first day of school:

- A complete change of clothes to be left at the center in case of accidents or spills
(i.e. pants, shirts, underwear, socks etc.)
- A pair of Slippers or crocks (**no indoor shoes or running shoes**)
- Water bottle or cup (to be taken home each night and cleaned)
- Healthy snack and lunch (**warning we are a peanut free at our school**)
- Muddy buddy or rain gear for outside time (**for younger children**)



Things parents need to remember:

- Preschool begins at 8:30 and ends at 12:30
- Please note, I will greet the children in the classroom at **8:20 am** and not before. If you are going to be late please phone or text to let me know.
- Please send your child dressed for play and dressed for the weather and for messy crafts.
- All forms including registration forms and **immunization records** must be filled out before the children can start school

A Typical Day

- 8:30 Welcome /Free Play
- 9:30-9:40 Clean up/ bathroom break
- 9:40 10:00 Morning Worship
- 10:00-10:30 Marvelous Munchies
- 10:30-11:00 Morning Group Time
- 11:00-11:40 Outside time/ Bathroom break
- 12:00-12:30 Pray/Lunch
- 12:30-1:30 Free Play
- 1:30-1:45 The Arts
- 1:45-2:15 Outside time/Bathroom break
- 2:15-3:00 Afternoon Group time
- 3:00 Home time
- 3:10 Arrival of Afterschool group

Free Play:

During this time, children choose from open activities from the classroom, ranging from dramatic play, musical instruments, blocks, cars.

(**self-direction, choice imagination, problem solving**)

Group Time:

Group time is an important part of the classroom's routine. It is a time for story and language development, music and movement activities, and other varied learning experiences. Children learn to respond to the needs of others while in a group situation (**unity, movement, memory, expression**)

Story Time:

We read and share a variety of stories relating a theme or letter of the week, Allows children to enter a world of "make believe", learn about new and exciting things (**listening, attention, language, literacy**)

Afternoon Group Time:

Children will have opportunities for sensory play allowing children to play and explore materials with all their senses, (sensory table include, sand, water, bean, rice, rocks, cornstarch goop) Manipulatives: help to develop gross motor and fine motor skills, (cutting, ripping paper, blocks, puzzles, games (**fine motor skills, sharing, following directions**))

Great Outdoors:

Each day children enjoy exploring the environment around them, where they continue to develop social skills and gross motor skills, (**gross motor skills, movement, socialization**)

Marvellous Munchies/ Lunch:

As children enjoy snack together, they practice table manners as well as develop social skills while they communicate with each other. (**Socialization, responsibility, nutrition, manners**)

The Arts:

A daily art activity linked to the letter of the week or theme allows children to mature in following directions, fine motor skills and creative expression. (**follow directions, creative expression, fine motor skills**)

Morning Worship:

We'll explore the incredible, indescribable awesome universe that God created and holds in his hands, through stories, songs. (**socialization, movement, literacy, listening**)
