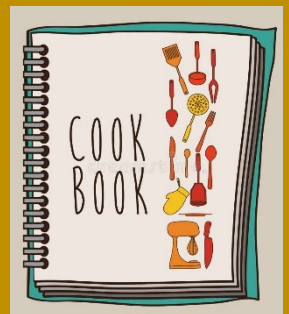
Volunteer wanted! The reprint of our Avalon Cookbook has been delayed since we learned that the cookbook company that
